### **DAY TO DAY CRUISE & STAY PROGRAM TENTATIVE ITINERARY JANUARY 24<sup>TH</sup> – FEBRUARY 7<sup>TH</sup> 2019**

#### **January 24<sup>th</sup>:**

This morning our limousine picks us up from home and transfers us to Pearson airport for our flight to New Orleans. Upon arrival in New Orleans we transfer to the Drury Inn, our home for the next three nights. Balance of the day at leisure.

#### **January 25<sup>th</sup>:**

Breakfast is served this morning from 6:00am until 9:30am. Today we meet our tour escort in the lobby at 8:30am for a city tour and our river cruise. The city tour will include a perimeter tour of the French Quarter, cemetery tour, City Park, and the Garden District including a drive down posh St. Charles Street. After our city tour we will board the Steamboat Natchez Paddle wheeler for our included 2-hour cruise up the Mississippi River. Enjoy light jazz music as well as a narration by the captain as he talks about life on the river, and the historical aspect of the Mississippi. After our cruise we transfer back to our hotel, or stroll around the French Quarter and return to the hotel on your own. Evening free – you may want to try your luck at Harrah`s Casino this evening!

#### **January 26<sup>th</sup>:**

Breakfast is served this morning between 6:00am and 9:30am. This morning we meet our escort in the lobby at 11:30am before we depart on our included Oak Plantation tour. Experience a bygone era in one of the South's most beautiful settings – Oak Alley Plantation, built in 1839. This historic plantation located on the Mississippi River in the community of Vacherie, Louisiana. It is protected as a National Historic Landmark. It is named after its distinguishing feature, an alley or canopied path created by a double row of live oaks about 800 feet (240 meters) long that was planted in the early 18th century, long before the present house was built. The alley runs between the house and the Mississippi River. Return to the hotel approximately 5:00pm. Evening at leisure. Note: there is a café at the plantation for light snacks only; you may want to bring a little extra to eat with you.

#### **January 27<sup>th</sup>:**

Today we transfer from our hotel to the cruise port where we board the fabulous 5 star Norwegian Breakaway. This 11-day sailing showcases the Western Caribbean's most exciting ports. In Ocho Rios, make the exhilarating climb up the limestone-terraced steps of Dunn's River Falls, 600 feet of beautiful cascades and pools surrounded by lush Jamaican rainforest. Visit Grand Cayman's famous Stingray City Sandbar to interact with and feed dozens of Southern Stingrays in the wild. Experience sun, fun and sand in Harvest Caye, our premier resort-style destination in Belize - cool off with a drink at the swim-up bar or snorkel the second-largest barrier reef in the world. And when you're in Cozumel, don't miss the chance to explore Mayan ruins, remnants of an ancient yet sophisticated civilization.
