ROCKY MOUNTAIN EXTENSION JULY 2nd – 6th 2023

July 2nd: After disembarkation from our fabulous Alaska Cruise we transfer to our downtown Vancouver hotel. This afternoon we'll enjoy a ½ day sightseeing tour of Vancouver. Highlights will include Chinatown, Gastown, Stanley Park and Granville Island. After our tour we'll return to the hotel. Balance of the day at leisure.

July 3rd: This morning we'll transfer from our hotel to the train station where we board the Rocky Mountaineer Train. Travel from the coastal city of Vancouver to Kamloops in the heart of British Columbia's interior. On today's journey you will see dramatic changes in scenery, from the lush green fields of the Fraser Valley through forests and winding river canyons surrounded by the peaks of the Coast and Cascade Mountains, to the desert like environment of the BC interior. Highlights include the rushing waters of Hell's Gate in the Fraser Canyon and the steep slopes and rock sheds along the Thompson River. Breakfast and lunch are included onboard. Your day concludes as the Rocky Mountaineer travels along the shores of Kamloops Lake into Kamloops between 5:30pm and 7:30pm. Spend the evening exploring the city of Kamloops or relaxing in your hotel room.

July 4th: This morning we'll transfer from our hotel back to the train station and re-board the Rocky Mountaineer Train. Today we continue our journey east to the mighty Canadian Rockies and the province of Alberta. Travel across ranch lands, along the rocky lakeshores over high mountain passes and through the remarkable tunnels that form part of the rich rail history of the Canadian Rockies. Highlights include Craigellachie, where the last spike of the Canadian Pacific Railway was driven, the climb over Rogers Pass, the Kicking Horse Canyon, the Spiral Tunnels and, the glaciers and snow-capped peaks of the Canadian Rockies. Breakfast and lunch are included onboard. Your expected arrival into Lake Louise is between 630pm and 830pm. Transfer to our Banff Hotel.

July 5th: After our included breakfast we'll depart on a half day sightseeing tour of this beautiful area. Fabulous picture postcard views everywhere you look will be highlighted by a spectacular eight minute gondola ride to the top of Sulphur Mountain for 360 degree view of the Banff town site and surrounding mountains. Return to the hotel for free time to shop and stroll around this very charming mountain town.

July 6th: We'll have an included breakfast this morning before checking out and boarding our coach to transfer to Calgary airport where we board our flight home to Toronto.
