TENTATIVE DAY TO DAY CRUISE & STAY ITINERARY

January 29th:

Our limousine will pick us up from home and transfers us to Pearson airport. We check in for our flight to New Orleans. Upon arrival in New Orleans we transfer to the Courtyard by Marriott, our home for the next four nights. Balance of the evening at leisure. **Overnight.**

January 30th:

Breakfast is included this morning. We will meet in the lobby for our deluxe city and cemetery tour. Marvel at all major highlights this fascinating city has to offer, experience the French Quarter, Jackson Square, visit an above ground cemetery, and marvel at the incredible mansions up and down St. Charles Street. We see famous landmarks; enjoy the Garden district and beautiful City Park. Return to the "Lighthouse" approximately 11:00am. We will then board our Paddle Wheeler for our river boat cruise. We enjoy jazz music, an included lunch onboard, and a commentary by the captain as we steam up the mighty Mississippi. After our cruise we disembark, then have a free afternoon down by the riverfront, or return to the hotel on the coach. If staying by the riverfront, return to the hotel on your own. **Overnight**.

Included is pickup at our hotel, a narrated boat cruise, transportation by air-conditioned coach, local guide, and all taxes. Other items not included are gratuities (optional), snacks and refreshments available for purchase on boat. Our tour will depart at 10:45am, report lobby 10:30am. Return to the hotel approximately 2:45pm. Cost \$105.00 Canadian Dollars. Otherwise you have another FREE DAY to do any shopping, or explore on your own. Suggested visits include Café du Monde, the flea market, Jackson Square, Bourbon Street, and the casino. Overnight.

February 2nd:

Breakfast is included this morning. Today we say goodbye to New Orleans as we embark on the next part of our fabulous vacation! We'll check out of our hotel and transfer to the pier to board our 5 star cruise ship, Norwegian's "Getaway", our home for the next 7 glorious nights! Alas the luxury cruise portion of our holiday is over today. Once we disembark from the ship we'll enjoy our Oak Alley Plantation Tour. Experience a bygone era in one of the South's most beautiful settings – Oak Alley Plantation, built in 1839. This historic plantation is located on the Mississippi River in the community of Vacherie, Louisiana. It is protected as a National Historic Landmark. It is named after its distinguishing feature, an alley or canopied path created by a double row of live oaks about 800 feet (240 meters) long that was planted in the early 18th century, long before the present house was built. The alley runs between the house and the Mississippi River. Note: there is a café at the plantation where you may purchase lunch (on your own). After our tour we'll transfer to New Orleans airport where we check in for our flight home. Upon arrival in Toronto we'll clear final customs and take our limousine service back to our homes! **WELCOME HOME!**



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
