Day One: Toronto to Vancouver

Today we are picked up at home and whisked off to Toronto's Pearson Airport where we board our flight to Vancouver. Upon arrival in Vancouver we'll be transferred to the Sutton Place Hotel. Day Two: Vancouver

Day Four: Rocky Mountaineer GOLD LEAF SERVICE Train Ride Kamloops - Banff

This morning we'll transfer back to Kamloops train station and re-board our luxury train. Once again we'll have breakfast onboard. We also have lunch included, gourmet snacks and unlimited beverages. Your journey takes you through a spectacular array of scenery as you travel between the glacier and snow-capped peaks of the Canadian Rockies, over mountain passes and through remarkable tunnels, along rocky lakeshores and across the ranch lands of the interior. Today's highlights include the Continental Divide, the Spiral Tunnels, the Kicking Horse Canyon, Rogers Pass and Craigellachie, where the last spike of the Canadian Pacific Railway was driven. You will arrive in Banff between 6:30pm and 8:00pm PT. Transfer to your Banff accommodation, the Ptarmigan Inn. Day Five: Full Day Banff and Lake Louise including Group Lunch at Emerald Lake Lodge.
