Atlantic Canada Itinerary September 8th – 21st 2026

Day One: We start our Atlantic Canada adventure today as we head toward “La Belle Province”, Quebec. Our first overnight stop will be the charming town of Drummondville, Quebec where you will enjoy your first night at the Quality Suites Drummondville.

Day Two: After breakfast we’ll depart for Fredericton. Fredericton is the capital of New Brunswick. Situated in the west-central portion of the province along the Saint John River, Fredericton is the third largest city in the province after Moncton and Saint John. We’ll overnight at the Holiday Inn Express. **B.**

Day Three: After breakfast we’ll depart Fredericton on route to the Hopewell Rocks, home of the world famous “flower pots” where we will have a guided tour. When the tour is completed we will board the bus and drive up to the Interpretive Centre. This afternoon we depart for Saint John via the very scenic Fundy Trail. Upon arrival in St. John we’ll visit Reversing Falls before checking into our hotel, the Chateau Saint John. **B.**

Day Four: After breakfast we will depart from our hotel and visit Saint John City Market Square before taking the ferry across the Bay of Fundy to Digby, Nova Scotia. Once we arrive in Digby we will check in at the luxurious Digby Pines Resort for two nights. **B.**

Day Five: After breakfast we’ll have an early morning departure for Port Royal. We will take the old Hwy 1 via the coastline. We will be travelling through Deep Brook, Cornwallis (former “boot camp” for English speaking recruits), Clementsport, and Allains Creek. Once we arrive at Port Royal there is a 1/2 hour guided tour. After our tour the bus departs for Annapolis Royal, where you will be dropped off on George Street, adjacent to Fort Anne. We will meet at Fort Anne, at a designated spot, for entry into Fort Anne. After our visit our bus departs for our return to Digby. This evening we’ll enjoy a three course dinner at the hotel. **B.D.**

Day Six: After breakfast we say goodbye to Digby as we travel to Halifax. On route we will visit the UNESCO World Heritage town of Lunenburg where we visit the Fisheries Museum of the Atlantic. After Lunenburg we will do a quick “photo stop” at Mahone Bay where we can get a great picture of “The Three Churches”. Peggy’s Cove is our last stop before arriving in Halifax. Nova Scotia is home to over 160 historic lighthouses, but no beacon is as photographed as the one in the vibrant fishing village of Peggy’s Cove! Built in 1915, Peggy’s Point Lighthouse still keeps watch over surging ocean waves and working lobster boats. Amble over giant rocks worn smooth by the sea and share in the view! Upon arrival in Halifax (the provincial capital of Nova Scotia) we’ll check into our hotel, The Four Points by Sheraton which is strategically located in the downtown core near Pier 21 and the Citadel. We’ll spend two comfortable nights at the Sheraton. **B.**

Day Seven: Breakfast included this morning. We will depart for Pier 21 for a guided tour before visiting the Halifax Seaport Farmers Market. Thereafter we’re off to tour Citadel Hill. Our last visit today will be Fairlawn Cemetery. Fairview Cemetery is a cemetery in Halifax, Nova Scotia, Canada. It is perhaps best known as the final resting place for over one hundred victims of the sinking of the Titanic. Tonight we’ll have an included dinner in Halifax’s lively waterfront area. **B. D.**



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Day Eight: After a hearty breakfast we'll depart Halifax for scenic Cape Breton. On route we'll stop for an included lunch. We'll visit the Alexander Graham Bell Museum before checking into our Sydney Nova Scotia hotel, the Holiday Inn Express located on the waterfront, where we'll stay for two nights. **B.L.**

Day Nine: After breakfast this morning. Today we're off for a full day of sightseeing on the world famous Cabot Trail. Of course we are hoping for great weather today for our drive around the Trail. We will be travelling clockwise which is the safest route for our bus. Along the route we will be stopping for photo ops in safe areas to pull off the highway. We'll have an included lunch in Cheticamp. Return to our hotel after this wonderfully scenic day! **B.L.**

Day Ten: After Breakfast we depart for Prince Edward Island via the Ferry. We leave from the terminal at Caribou N.S. and arrive at the Woods Island ferry terminal in P.E.I. Once in P.E.I we go to the Avonlea Village. Avonlea was the fictitious name that Lucy Maud Montgomery gave to Cavendish. In addition to the original schoolhouse she taught in, the Minister's residence and the 1872 Historic Long River Church, Avonlea Village offers replications of houses and shops from the time of Anne of Green Gables. We then proceed to our hotel, the Rodd Royalty (our home for the next two nights). This evening we'll have a delicious Lobster Dinner at famous Fisherman's Wharf in North Rustico! After dinner we return to the hotel. **B.D.**

Day Eleven: After breakfast our coach departs for Cavendish and Green Gables Heritage Place. Green Gables Heritage Place is a 19th century farm and literary landmark in Cavendish. Green Gables served as the setting for the Anne of Green Gables novels by Lucy Maud Montgomery. After our visit we'll go to Avonlea Village for lunch (on your own). We'll then visit Cows Gateway Centre at the base of the Confederation Bridge before going back to our hotel. **B.**

Day Twelve: Breakfast again this morning is included. Alas it's time to depart from this quaint province. We will take the impressive Confederation Bridge, the longest bridge in the world crossing ice-covered water. The toll bridge spans a 12.9 km stretch of the Northumberland Strait connecting Borden-Carleton, Prince Edward Island, to Cape Jourimain, New Brunswick. We'll head for Edmundson, N.B. with a lunch break in Moncton followed by a short break in Grand Falls. We'll arrive late afternoon to the Grey Rock Hotel. Dinner on your own this evening. Try your luck as there is a casino here in Edmundson. **B.**

Day Thirteen: After breakfast we're off to the very cosmopolitan city of Montreal. We'll start early as our goal is to arrive in Montreal before rush hour traffic becomes heavy. Upon arrival we'll check into our downtown hotel, the Hampton Inn by Hilton. We'll have time to freshen up before going out for our farewell dinner in Old Montreal. **B. D.**



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Day Fourteen: We've had a wonderful Atlantic Canada experience over the last thirteen days, but alas it's time to head home! After breakfast we'll check out of our hotel and have a short city tour before heading "Nord Ouest" for Sudbury, carrying with us many fond memories of our Eastern provinces! **B.**
