Tentative Day to Day Itinerary

July 28th – 31st or September 7th – 10th 2026

DAY ONE:

This morning we board our fully equipped luxury highway coach which will take us to the fabulous Caesar's Windsor Resort. We will stop on our way to Windsor for lunch (on your own). After lunch we will continue on to our final destination, Windsor. Our arrival at our award winning 4 diamond 5 star river front resort will be approximately 3:00pm. After check in, the hotel and casino are yours to enjoy. The hotel has a variety of dining options from upscale to casual. Their world class casino has a myriad of gaming possibilities. **GOOD LUCK!**

DAY TWO:

We meet this morning at 8:00am in the bus departures area. We'll have a short bus ride over to the Leamington Dock where we board a ferry for a relaxing 1 ½ hour trip across Lake Erie to Pelee Island. While on the island, we'll have a step on guide to give us a comprehensive overview of the nature, history and geography of this natural habitat. Pelee Island is the southerly most point in Canada and is as far south as you can travel while remaining in Canada. It is home to some spectacular natural areas. A hotspot for migrating birds, you'll often see amazing species here that you won't see at home. The climate here is milder than the mainland, resulting in excellent conditions for growing grapes. While on the Island we will have lunch at the Pelee Island Winery and do some wine tasting. We'll spend some time touring the island before returning by ferry to the mainland. Our return ferry departs at 4:00pm. We return to the hotel approximately 6:30pm. Balance of the evening free.

DAY THREE:

After breakfast (on your own) we'll meet the bus and be joined by "Bennie the Weasel" and his friends, they will point various sites where the Rum Runners smuggled illegal liquor into the U.S.A. This exciting tour will bring us back to the prohibition days in the 1920s, when Windsor was a main supplier of illegal liquor to the likes of Al Capone and other mobsters. Windsor's bootlegging stories are colourful and fascinating, and this tour will bring it all to life, along with a lot of fun. We enjoy an included buffet lunch at Franko's with live entertainment. After lunch we tour the Walkerville neighbourhood, where many of the mansions were built with money made from smuggling operations. We tour the Willistead Mansion previously owned by the Hiram Walker family. Return to the hotel, balance of the day is free to enjoy the hotel facilities or try your luck at the casino.
